



Summer ASEP is Coming to Dare County!

Dare County Schools understands the importance of quality summer child care and the challenge working parents face in finding viable options. We know that students without structured learning activities facilitated by caring adults who engage them in cooperative play and investigations can be at risk over the summer months. As such, Dare County Schools seeks to begin a program to help fill a desperate need for families of young children while providing a challenging, yet fun program where children can continue to grow socially, emotionally, and academically until they return to school in August. We're proud to announce the transformation of the after-school enrichment program into the "**All Summer Enrichment Program**" this June! Our goal is to provide a weekly child care option for working parents throughout the summer. We ask that you commit to having your child attend the full summer, rather than a week by week enrollment. (Of course, we understand there may be a few weeks that may be missed for family trips!)

All Summer Enrichment Program (Summer ASEP) is a full summer of fun as children age 6-11 will travel "Around the World in 40 Days", this year's summer program theme. Each week children will learn about a different region or country in our world through arts and crafts, Science, Math, and Reading activities.

Hours and Dates of Operation:

Monday – Friday from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm

Beginning the week of June 18th and ending on August 10th, 2018

Locations and Enrollment Capacities:

Cape Hatteras Elementary School (40)

Manteo Elementary School (80)

First Flight Elementary School--serving Nags Head Elementary as well as FFES (60)

Kitty Hawk Elementary School (60)

Cost:

\$170 per child per week (includes breakfast, lunch and two snacks each day)

Fee is based on a "break even" cost analysis for staffing, supplies/materials, and field trips.

Because of this, we will not offer discounted rates for partial weeks or multiple child discounts.

Read to Achieve Reading Camp participants will be able to attend at a prorated rate.

One week scholarships will be available to eligible families through JCPC and Community of Juvenile Services.

Enrollment Process:

Complete the ASEP application linked on the Dare County Schools' website and return it to the school's ASEP site coordinator, along with the bottom portion of this letter. *If you have already completed an application for the 18-19 school year, simply return the bottom portion of this letter letting us know you want your child/children enrolled. Enrollment will be open until capacities are reached.*
