Point of Emphasis

- All of the information that is shared with you today is required of all Dare County Schools' High School Student-Athletes.
 - The information contained in Policy 3105 and in the revision of Policy 3620 applies to all Dare County Schools Student-Athletes

- Policy 3105 and the revision of Policy 3620 do not require any additional information from current Dare County Schools Student-Athletes
 - The information requested from Home-School Students who wish to try-out for Dare County Schools' High School Athletic Teams is information that is already on file for our current students



First Steps...

The Home-School Student must notify the Principal of the assigned school in writing of the student's intent to try-out for an athletic team at least <u>10 days</u> prior to the first practice.

- Friday, February 3, 2023

The first official day of practice is Monday, February 13, 2023

For Initial Admission...

Parents of Homeschooled Students will provide school officials with:

- Academic records from the previous and current years, as well as: (Policy 3620)
 - A transcript
 - Attendance Record
 - Record of Immunizations
- Proof that the Home-School Student has been enrolled in a registered Home-School for the prior 365 days (Policy 3620)
- Results of an achievement test, taken within the last year, that indicate the student is on-grade level (Policy 3620)



Requirements for Home-School Student Participation in High School Athletics

- Attend High School in the student's Attendance Zone (Policy 4120)
- Be enrolled in 2 classes (Policy 3105)
- Take, at least, one class on campus (Policy 3105)
- Must pass all classes in which they are enrolled at school to maintain eligibility (Policy 3620)

- Maintain continuous Dual Enrollment or will be ineligible for 365 days (Policy 3620)
- Participate in all required district, state, and federal testing (Policy 3105)
- Adhere to the Dare County Schools Student Code of Conduct (Policy 3105)

Requirements for Home-School Student Participation in High School Athletics (con't.)

- Participation will be determined by the North Carolina High School Athletic Association and all other defined parties (Policy 3620)
- Parent/Guardian will assume responsibility for transportation to and from school (Policy 3105)

 Student must maintain attendance with an active, registered Home-School (Policy 3620)

Throughout the Sports Season...

It will be the responsibility of the Parent/Student to provide the Sports Season Coach with regular updates, to be determined by the Coach and Parent, on Student Attendance and successful Academic Progress in Home-School courses. (Policy 3400)

- Written notification to Principals by Friday, February 3, 2023
- The First Official Day for Spring Sports Season Tryouts is Monday, February 13, 2023

 - Revisions to Policy 3620 to be compatible with new Policy 3105
